



Dear Parents and Students,

The Holy Ghost Prep VEX ROBOTICS team is preparing for another exciting season, and we are hoping that you will be a part of it! We are **Team #242: The Firebirds**. We currently consist of HGP students from all grades, and have also invited students to join us from *Villa Joseph Marie*. If you are interested in learning the engineering design process, and learning how to apply that skill to the creation/programming of a competitive robot, then this club is for you! You do not need any prior robotics experience (although that always helps) -- we are simply looking for individuals who are excited to learn this skill and to be a part of the team.

The following are answers to a few frequently asked questions:

#### **What does it look like to be on the team?**

Students form teams of 2-4 members, and work together during the season to design/build/program a robot. It is a fair amount of 'learning the ropes' through trial and error, which is highlighted in the engineering design process. The team meets on Monday-Wednesday-Thursdays in Founders room F301 at HGP, from 2:30 to 5 PM. Students from other schools typically need to find transportation to and from the lab after school. This year we are also launching a brand new 3-week *Summer VEX Robotics* class at HGP. #### **What does a season look like?**

The season is broken up into two halves, the early season (Aug-Sept-Oct), and late season (Jan-Feb). The late season would extend into March if the team qualifies for the state championship, and into April if they qualify for the US Open or World Championship. Each student/team needs to be available to build 2-3 times a week through September and October. This will culminate in our HOME opener at the end of October. Any students/teams who want to continue their season after that point, would pick up again in January. As a side note, all competitions throughout the season are held on Saturdays, and dates for those will not be known until October.

#### **What are the requirements for being on the team?**

Before the school year begins, students will be sent an availability questionnaire to fill out – they need to make themselves available for Sept/Oct, and be present at the HOME opener. There is also a \$150 club participation fee for all club members. This covers all expenses for the *entire regular season*, including transportation and registration fees, all robot parts and tools that the team will use, and also a team jersey (that the student gets to keep). Additional fees are only accrued if an individual team qualifies for a competition out of state.
